Bro. Andrew - 50 years in the Craft

Well deserved recognition to a well respected Brother



At our Regular Meeting on 1st February 2010, the RWM, Bro. Philip J. Titley along with the Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master Bro. Allan J. Marshall presented Bro. Andrew Burrell PM with his Jubilee Certificate from The Grand Lodge of Scotland to mark 50 years as a Freemason.

Brother Andrew was Initiated on 18 January 1960, Passed on 7th March 1960 and Raised on 11 April 1960 and was Installed as Right Worshipful Master in 1972, 1973 and again in 1975. Being a true Master of his Craft, Brother Andrew has been an Installing Master no less than 13 times and has given an Oration at Melrose Abbey at The annual Masons Walk in 1991, 2001 and 2005.

Further to his dedication and support to the Lodge, Andrew was awarded Distinguished Service Membership of the Lodge in 1982 and received Honorary Grand Lodge Rank of Bible Bearer in 1984. Not only a dedicated supporter to the Lodge, Andrew was an active member of the Provincial Grand Lodge of Roxburgh, Peebles and Selkirk Shires and held the office of Depute Provincial Grand Master from 1990 to 1995.
